
- Provided over \$180,000 in funding to support a variety of K-12 educational initiatives

- Offered continued support to programs that address the needs of the Souderton Area School District and the communities it serves
- Continued to provide a vehicle for individuals, businesses, and organizations to share resources and gifts with the Souderton Area School District and its students




The Greenhouse Project

The vision and purpose of this project has been in the works for well over a decade. As students and teachers worked side by side in the classroom and within the SAVE organization (Students Against Violating the Earth) the question was never “Why?”, but rather, “How?”. Funding a project of this magnitude requires a unique formula of collaboration, cooperation, and passion. The family of Cindy Kilmer (SAHS '73) spent a significant amount of time searching for just the right way to remember their beloved daughter, sister, and mother. This opportunity was precisely what they wished for and last spring thanks to the collaboration of community and school, we dedicated a new state of the art learning space.

The SASD Greenhouse will facilitate hands on learning opportunities for students offering real-world problem solving, STEM-related science, differentiation, personal skill development, community collaboration, and career exploration in agriculture, business, environmental science, and more.

The Greenhouse is at its core, represents precisely why the IVEF is an important and valuable resource to the Souderton Area School District. By bringing the resources of the community to our district we can provide significant opportunities to each one of our students.

IQWST Science

In 2019 the IVEF invested \$35,000 in SASD middle school students by supporting a new science curriculum called IQWST, (Investigating and Questioning our World Through Science and Technology). This curriculum is research based, supported by the National Science Foundation, and aligns with NGSS (Next Generation Science Standards). IQWST takes learning to the next level by encouraging student-focused activities in the classroom that in turn provide a better understanding of the topic they are studying. These activities incorporate reading, writing, collaboration, and hands-on participation to promote learning and retention.



Love your Library Innovation Grants \$18,000 in Funding Provided

21st-Century Libraries are the center of so much exploratory learning. Libraries become a different kind of learning destination when schools reimagine them as open, transparent spaces that invite student communication and collaboration.

Each year the IVEF evaluates the most effective ways we can make an impact in each of our schools. In the 2018-2019 school year we took a new direction in our Innovation Grant program and offered each building the opportunity to submit grants that would support the transformation of the school libraries! Each building was eligible for up to \$2,000 in funding to support ideas that would best accommodate the culture and needs of their school community.

The results were overwhelming! From puppet theaters to creation stations, 3D Printers and STEM based centers complete with hissing cockroaches, each building embraced the opportunity to think outside the box to enhance learning for every student



IVEF FUNDING AT WORK IN OUR SCHOOLS

E.M. Crouthamel Elementary:

- Love Your Library grant equipped the library with a flat screen TV, Cuddle-Up Floor pillows, and a Deluxe Floor Model Theater
- Helping Hands fund to assist students in need
- Funding for 5th Grade classroom libraries
- Support for new playground

Franconia Elementary:

- Love Your Library grant provided an Innovation Creation Station in the library, complete with tables that can easily fit together, Learniture chairs, a talking globe, Lego bricks, Keva planks, and mobile organizers
- Helping Hands fund to assist students in need
- Funding for 5th Grade classroom libraries

Oak Ridge Elementary:

- Love Your Library grant supported the continued transformation of Oak Ridge Elementary's library into an innovative space that includes a puppet theater and puppet tree, Cubelets, and K'Nex Maker Kit and gears
- Funding for 5th Grade classroom libraries

Salford Hills Elementary:

- Love Your Library grant provided funding for New Wave tables and smaller, lighter, more comfortable chairs that can be used to create a more productive learning space in Salford Hills Elementary's library
- Funding for 5th Grade classroom libraries

Vernfield Elementary:

- Love your Library Grant provided a 3D printer and filament used by the students at Vernfield to provide opportunities to work individually or collaboratively to solve problems and create useful items
- Funding for 5th Grade classroom libraries

West Broad Street Elementary:

- Love Your Library grant supported the purchase of STEAM-based centers to extend, bolster, and complement the K–5 science curriculum. Each grade level has a complementary center for each trimester
- Helping Hands fund to assist students in need
- Funding for 5th Grade classroom libraries

Indian Crest Middle School: *

- Love Your Library grant supported the creation of a Library of Life Enrichment which allows students to borrow nontraditional items from the library, including: telescope, guitar, a sewing machine, a Makey-Makey Kit, microscope, crochet hooks, banjo, ukulele, keyboard, and binoculars along with books to teach students how to use these materials.

Indian Valley Middle School: *

- Love Your Library Innovation grant provided two Oculus Rift Touch Virtual Reality systems along with software and hardware for students to create, design, and draw in 3D in a virtual reality environment.

“The best part about the program is that it allows students to become scientists as they encounter and uncover phenomena and begin to unravel the scientific principles at work. Students are also exposed to a variety of scientific content in each grade and will build upon previous knowledge both within each school year and each grade level. Some highlights include: examining invasive species by dissecting sea lamprey and perch, making new substances, (specifically making soap from two unlikely substances), and investigating how food provides our bodies with energy.”

Souderton Area High School:

- Love Your Library Innovation grant was used to create small group collaboration stations complete with large monitors, mounts, splitters, and cables which students and staff can connect to their own devices creating a space to be used by classes, independent study groups, and staff in the Souderton Area High School Library.
- The IVEF spearheaded the funding support of a 1400 square foot state-of-the-art Greenhouse that will be utilized by students and the SASD community to learn botany, horticulture, business, biology, and chemistry.

2018-2019 Fundraising & Events

Big Red Rooster Scramble:

Our 6th year in partnership with the Harleysville Rotary, hosting our annual Golf Outing, which was a huge success bringing in over \$35,000 which will fund educational initiatives for SASD as well as service projects in our community supported by the Rotary Club of Harleysville. Big Red Bash:

The Big Red Bash was held in September of 2018 in partnership with Bergey's Buick GMC. A district-wide event that included participation from each of our schools - there was a car show, a variety of sports clinics, raffles, games and prizes, and guests had a chance to test drive the latest and greatest Buick and GMC cars and trucks!

Tastings of the Indian Valley:

An annual culinary event highlighting select local restaurants, breweries and wineries and showcasing their favorite dishes. The IVEF has been the non-profit partner for this event, hosted by the Indian Valley Chamber of Commerce. Hundreds of community members come to enjoy an evening of food and conversation!

Holiday and Year -End Teacher Appreciation Campaigns:

Each December and May, families are encouraged to donate in any amount in honor of their child's teacher! Teachers receive a personalized certificate acknowledging each donation made on their behalf. It makes a great gift during the holidays or at the end of the school year! The funds are used to support the IVEF Innovation Grants program available to teachers throughout the District.

Boon Supply, Co.:

Held in the Spring, and again in the Fall, this district-wide fundraiser allows families to purchase a variety of eco-friendly bags and other items through Boon Supply Company (formerly Mixed Bag Designs). In addition to versatile reusable bags, there are home and kitchen essentials available.

SAHS Graduation Signs:

A new tradition was started in Souderton this year. Families of graduating seniors honored their graduates by purchasing yard signs personalized with their graduate's name. They are wonderful yard markers for graduation parties. Keep a sharpie handy, have friends and family sign them for a special keepsake. Sales will begin again in early spring!

Principal Vernfield Elementary School



When I graduated from Souderton Area High School and headed to Millersville University to pursue a teaching degree, I knew that I wanted to come back to Souderton. My experiences at Souderton schools - Lower Salford, Indian Valley, and Souderton Area High School - drove my career choice. More importantly, with the exception of my parents, Souderton teachers were the most influential force upon me during my formative years. Along with expected academic learning, my teachers taught me about leadership, empathy, and how to view the world beyond Souderton.

Now, as a principal in Souderton, I see that the opportunities and resources for teaching and learning go beyond those that were once available to me as a student. This is due, in large part, to the success of the Indian Valley Education Foundation. The IVEF has supported countless teachers and students in all nine of our schools. From innovation grants to support classroom learning, to working with community donors to build a greenhouse on the grounds of Souderton Area High School, the IVEF has become a crucial partner in educating the whole child.
